✗ “Install complete” texts with no verification · ✗ Technicians self-certifying their own work · ✗ Property managers calling about “missed” installs · ✗ “Customer wasn’t home” with no documentation · ✗ Techs logging 4 hours for 90-minute jobs

What Property Managers & Building Owners Want:

✓ **Proof** that all equipment was installed and tested · ✓ **Photos** of completed wiring and mounted equipment · ✓ **Timestamps** showing arrival, completion, departure · ✓ **Sign-off** from a supervisor who verified the work

SLIDE 3: Introducing Verified Execution

Work Isn't Done Until Someone ELSE Says It's Done.

Traditional: Technician: "I finished the 8-unit satellite install." ✓ Done

Verified Execution: Technician: "I finished the 8-unit satellite install." → Lead Tech Reviews Photos → **VERIFIED** ✓ Now it's Done

Why This Works:

1. **No self-verification** — Techs submit, supervisors confirm
2. **Built-in QC checkpoint** — Catch wiring issues before service calls
3. **Legal-grade documentation** — Timestamped, verified, exportable
4. **Zero ambiguity** — Green means verified. Bill it.


